Dear P Alert Ltd

On 27 November 2018 at the ESR laboratory, Auckland I tested two devices/sensors for whether they could detect methamphetamine vapour. The devices were documented to be called "P Alert MK3".

Both sensors were secured to the roof of an approximately 0.064 m³ perspex box. Methamphetamine hydrochloride was vapourised in the box using an electric hotplate.

When approximately 0.01 grams of methamphetamine hydrochloride was vapourised-

 P Alert MK3 was documented to have sent a text message to your mobile phone reading "SENSOR ALARM ACTIVATED: PPM10".

When approximately 0.03 grams of methamphetamine hydrochloride was vapourised-

 P Alert MK3 was documented to have sent a text message to your mobile phone reading "SENSOR ALARM ACTIVATED: PPM162".
